**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION
REPORT**

8 This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of
9 Arizona on December 11, 2004, pursuant to Rule 58(e), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration
10 of the Hearing Officer's Report filed October 7, 2004, recommending acceptance of the
11 Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint
12 Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum)
13 providing for a censure, two years of probation with the State Bar's Law Office
14 Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) including a practice monitor (PM),
15 compliance with the court's assessment of attorneys' fees against him, and costs of these
16 disciplinary proceedings. The Commission requested oral argument. The Respondent and
17 counsel for the State Bar were present.

20 **Decision**

21 The Commission's standard of review is set forth in Rule 58(b), which states that
22 the Commission reviews questions of law *de novo*. In reviewing findings of fact made by
23 a hearing officer, the Commission applies a clearly erroneous standard. Mixed findings of
24 fact and law are also reviewed *de novo*. *State v Blackmore*, 186 Ariz. 630, 925 P.2d 1347
25 (1996) citing *State v. Winegar*, 147 Ariz. 440, 711 P.2d 579 (1985).

1 Therefore, having found no findings of fact clearly erroneous, the nine¹ members of
2 the Commission unanimously recommend adopting and incorporating by reference² the
3 Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for a censure,
4 two years of probation (LOMAP with a PM), compliance with the court's assessment of
5 attorneys' fees against him, and costs. The terms of probation are as follows:

6 **Terms of Probation**

7 1. Respondent shall comply with the court's assessment of attorneys' fees
8 against him, subject to any remedies legally available to Respondent.

9 2. Respondent shall contact the director of LOMAP. The LOMAP director or
10 designee will conduct an audit of Respondent's law office. The recommendations of the
11 LOMAP director shall then be incorporated as additional terms of probation ordered
12 pursuant to the agreement.

13 3. Respondent shall obtain a practice monitor acceptable to the State Bar. The
14 practice monitor with whom Respondent is currently working is acceptable to the State
15 Bar.

16 4. In the event that Respondent fails to comply with any of the foregoing
17 conditions, and the State Bar receives information, bar counsel shall file with the Hearing
18 Officer a Notice of Non-Compliance, pursuant to Rule 60(a)5, Ariz. R. S. Ct. The Hearing
19 Officer shall conduct a hearing within thirty days after receipt of said notice, to determine
20 whether the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be
21 imposed. In the event there is an allegation that any of these terms have been violated, the

burden of proof shall be on the State Bar of Arizona to prove non-compliance by clear and convincing evidence.
