Mr. Coventry noted a potential error in the fee schedule contained in ACJA § 7-202 regarding the Inactive Status renewal fee. Mr. Coventry indicated he believes a double jeopardy scenario could exist if the Board enters findings and sanctions against a certificate holder if the Court has previously sanctioned a fiduciary. Mr. Coventry questioned whether the Board had the authority to substantiate a complaint allegation in matters where the Probable Cause Evaluator did not find probable cause exists.
